COMMUNICATION & LANGUAGE

This term we will be practising listening and responding to who questions. We will talk in full sentences and practice using the correct tense. We will continue to learn new words from stories we read.



PSE DEVELOPMENT

This half term we will meet Jigsaw Jennie. We will talk about our strengths and discuss that being different makes us all special. We will learn how to use our words to solve our problems.

We will continue to learn new phase 2 sounds in phonics and will begin applying this knowledge to guided reading sessions.

We will continue to blend phase 2 sounds to hear and read words in captions and short sentences.

We will learn how to write captions and labels using our phonics knowledge.

LITERACY

Our core texts are... Stanleys Stick by John Hegley
The leaf thief by Alice Hemming

PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

We will learn group games in the outdoor playground and we will spend time with the city coach learning object control and multi-skills.



MATHEMATICS

We will practice our counting skills by playing maths games and listening to songs and nursery rhymes. We will practice each object as we count. We will also begin to explore parts and wholes through looking at our own body parts as well as the parts of our favourite toys.



UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD

We will learn about light and dark and will explore light in dark places. We will look at the natural world and observe changes linked to Autumn. We are going to be immersed in different celebrations, including Christmas, remembrance, Diwali and Bonfire night.



EXPRESSIVE ART & DESIGN

We are going to create light and dark pictures, learn how to create a transient picture and have lots of fun creating Christmas and winter crafts. We will also be learning and performing songs for our nativity.
