In our science lesson today, we sorted and grouped liquids, solids and gases.

"I thought whipped cream was a solid/liquid but, now I realise that it is a liquid/gas because the gas creates the bubbles in the cream which makes it light and fluffy," said Hannah.

Tomasz said, "I didn't know that if a sponge had some water on it, it can be a solid/liquid/gas because of the air inside of it. I thought it would only be a solid/liquid."

"I thought sand was a gas, but know I know it is a solid which is made up of very small particles," explained Isla.
