What tests will my child take?

At the end of Year 6, children sit tests in:

- Grammar, punctuation and spelling (GPS)
- Reading
- Maths

These tests are both set and marked externally.

Science and Writing will also be assessed but will be teacher assessed not a formal test.

Key Stage 2 Reading

A single paper with questions based on three passages. Your child will have one hour, including reading time, to complete the test.



Key Stage 2 spelling, punctuation and grammar test

There are two papers for this test: 1) Grammar and punctuation paper requires short answers, lasting 45 minutes,

2) Aural spelling test of 20 words, lasting around 15 minutes

Monday 12th May 2025

English grammar, punctuation and spelling Paper 1: questions English grammar, punctuation and spelling Paper 2: spelling

Tuesday 13th May 2025 English reading

Wednesday 14th May 2025 Mathematics Paper 1: arithmetic Mathematics Paper 2: reasoning

Thursday 15th May 2025 Mathematics Paper 3: reasoning

How will Key Stage 2 SATs be marked?

After each test, the papers are sealed in an envelope ready to be collected for external marking.

In your child's end-of-year report, you will be given their raw score (the actual number of marks they get), alongside their scaled score and whether they have reached the expected standard set by the Department for Education ('NS' means that the expected standard was not achieved and 'AS' means the expected standard was achieved).

The range of scaled scores available for each KS2 test is:

80 (the lowest scaled score that can be awarded)

120 (the highest scaled score)

The expected standard for each test is a scaled score of 100-120.

Greater depth is considered to be a score of 110-120.

Key Stage 2 Science

Science is teacher assessed. There is no externally set test.

Key Stage 2 Writing

The children do not sit a writing test. Children's writing is based on teacher assessment across a range of writing in different styles. This is often open to the judgement of external moderators who will visit the school to verify the results by reading the children's writing and engaging in discussions with the class teacher.
