



Art Challenge Number 10: Crazy collage faces

Hi everyone,

This week you can have fun making up new characters using collage. Inspired by the artist Pablo Picasso, you can create new faces and characters. You will need magazines to cut up, but if you don't have any, you could print some pictures of faces from the internet. You could even print photos of your family and mix and match them all up!

Art Challenge Number 10:

<u>You will need:</u>

-Magazines to cut up and or/ pictures from the internet

-scissors

- -background paper to stick your work on to.
- -glue (to stick the pieces down, but you could just place them in position and take a photo).

Instructions:

- Look at the images of Picasso's portraits. They are ABSTRACT portraits, which means they aren't meant to be realistic. This art style is called CUBISM.
- 2. Cut out pictures of faces from different magazines or from the internet.
- 3. Choose the biggest face to act as a background for you to stick your new features onto. Place it on a plain background.
- 4. Cut lots of features; eyes, nose etc and make a pile of different features to choose from.
- 5. Play around with the features to create a new face. Think about the COMPOSITION which means where on the page you position each feature. You can make your face ABSTRACT like Picasso's if you want to put features in strange places!
- 6. When finished, either stick them down or just place them in position and take a photo of your creation.
