Congratulations and a huge well done to everyone. We are so proud of all of you for the dedication and perseverance you have shown towards learning during lockdown.

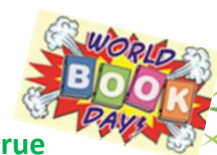


Dates for your diary!
